We took a trip to Paris in June and had to include a couple of photos of the Louvre and Notre Dame with the kids.



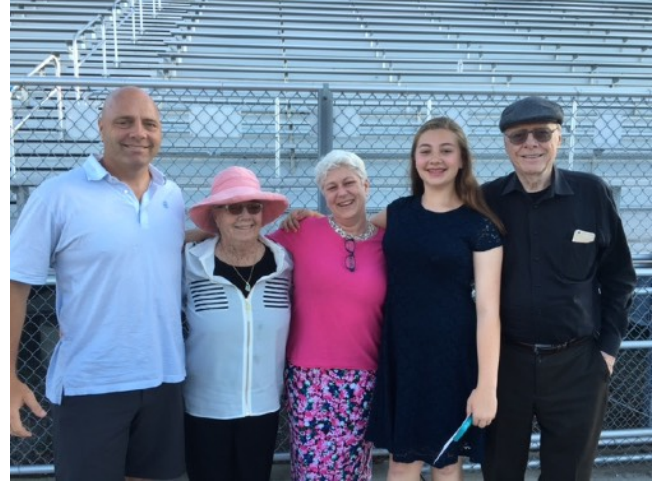
